
FROM THE DESK OF S THE CEO

About 200 people were in attendance, including Mr. Ben Swartz, Chairman of the South Africa Zionist Federation, Mr. Itai Melchior, Israel Embassy Trade Attaché and several African business men and women. The event was very successful as it served to measure public interest and the need for the establishment of the Africa Israel Chamber of Commerce. Later in the year the continental launch of AICC took place in Jerusalem during the biennial Africa Leadership Summit. AFRICA CELEBRATES JERUSALEM

This initiative is gathering 1 million signatures to declare that 'JERUSALEM IS THE ETERNAL CAPITAL OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE AND THE ETERNAL HOME OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH'. It forms part of Africa's contribution to the celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the Unification of Jerusalem.

The first edition of the signatures was printed into a book and presented to the leaders of Israel during the 2017 Africa Leadership Summit held in August in Jerusalem. The project will continue until it reaches the targeted 1 million signatures of Africans at home and in the diaspora.

AFRICA LEADERSHIP SUMMIT (ALS) -SOUTHERN AFRICA

The Southern Africa regional summit of ALS was held between 21 and 29 April in four cities of Southern Africa: Maseru in Lesotho, Pretoria and Soweto in South Africa, and Harare in Zimbabwe. Pastor Benjamin Berger from Jerusalem was our guest speaker, joined by Pastor David Kaberere from Nakuru, Kenya, Pastor Segun Olanipekun and Apostle Linda Gobodo from South Africa.

The Pretoria session was jointly hosted by the ICLD and the Speaker of the City of Tshwane Municipality, Councilor Kathlego Mathebe at the Tshwane City Chamber. The turnout was amazing, and many leaders from across the greater city of Tshwane attended. The Prayer Session was the first of its kind in the city. Gateway News & Joy Magazine covered the story and the video went viral. We believe God for many fruits from this strategic transaction linking the destiny of South Africa to Israel through the capital city of Pretoria.

In Zimbabwe, Dr Alexander Chisango under the banner of the World Economic Congress mobilized a number of national leaders for the summit which made the meeting truly a gathering of elders. Different sectors from all over Zimbabwe were represented.

Lesotho was hosted by the "Women in Evangelism" team. Key leaders from different parts of the country participated and the turnout was very good. Each of the cities was connected to Israel in a prophetic action led by Pastor Segun and Benjamin Berger and other ALS Apostolic leaders present.

Here are some of the highlights of the Summit:

- * Official launch of the Africa Israel Chamber of Commerce by the Mayor of Jerusalem, Mr. Nir Barkat. The launch marked the official opening of the highway of business and innovations by the Africa Leadership Summit between Africa and Israel, which has been part of the agenda of the ALS since its inception. African businessmen and - women were able to meet with the Israeli business community. An international executive team was also inaugurated to provide leadership for the new Chamber.
- * A wonderful time of fellowship between Africans and Israeli families during the Gala dinner.
- * Presentation of the first edition book of signatures of 'Africa Celebrates Jerusalem' to Israeli dignitaries – Nathan Sharansky, head of the Jewish Agency, Ambassador Gil Haskel, head of the Mashaf and Mr. Nir Barkat, Mayor of Jerusalem.
- ★ Introduction of the Africa Agency.
